WHAT ARE DEED RESTRICTIONS?

Committee of Five

<u>Deed restrictions are written agreements that restrict, or limit, the use of activities that may take place on property in a subdivision</u>. These restrictions appear in the real property records of the county in which the property is located. They are private agreements and are binding upon every owner in a subdivision. <u>All future owners become a party to these agreements when they purchase property in deed restricted areas.</u>

A primary purpose of most deed restrictions is preserving the residential character of a subdivision by keeping out commercial and industrial facilities. For people who prefer to live in a wholly residential environment, deed restrictions are desirable.

<u>Deed restrictions may legally prohibit a person from operating certain types of businesses from their home.</u> In Houston, where property is not governed by deed restrictions, a property owner may be free to operate a commercial business in the neighborhood. **Deed restrictions are powerful tools to help preserve the character of a subdivision or neighborhood.**

Every homeowner should have received a copy of deed restrictions upon purchase. However, it has been brought to OSBCA's attention, that this is not happening.

If you did not receive a copy of your deed restrictions when closing on your home, or have not received a copy from the Deed Restriction Committee, if sent a violation letter, one may obtain a copy from the Harris County Clerk at (713-755-6411) or visit their web site at www.cclerk.hctx.net. Please read your deed restrictions to be in compliance. Contact an OSB Civic Association board member (found in the Bugler newsletter) before beginning any new construction and/or remodeling.

We are striving to make OSB a desirable community in which you enjoy living. Be proud of your subdivision and abide by the deed restrictions. Your property value is important.





BEAUTIFICATION

For several weeks, the Solid Waste Department got behind in collecting Heavy Trash in Old Spring Branch. Finally, September 24 was Tree ONLY Heavy trash and in most cases, Tree Heavy was picked up. However, Solid Waste has not collected JUNK Heavy Trash for two months. August Junk Heavy Trash is still lying on the curbs.

Hopefully, October Junk heavy trash pick-up will eliminate the problem. Collections should be caught up October. After October 22, Heavy Trash violations will be reported to 3-1-1. A citation will be in order.

Residents should put the appropriate Heavy Trash out three to four days before the collection date, (the fourth Thursday of the month). If YOUR heavy trash is NOT picked up, call 3-1-1. Get a reference number. Then call Solid Waste at 832-393-0430.

Residents failing to follow deed restrictions are in violation of devaluating their property. Violation of any and every City of Houston Code is subject to a 3-1-1 citation.

Please, be so kind as to keep your yards, ditches, streets cleared of litter. Help keep our neighborhood clean!

DEED RESTRICTION VIOLATIONS

Notify the City of Houston's Legal Department if you suspect that a permit violates your community's deed restrictions regarding any of the following areas:

- Building use
- Setbacks
- Lot and/or building size
- Building height
- Number of structures on lot
- Fence height

Please verify your deed restrictions before filing a complaint. If you do not have a copy of the deed restrictions for your area, you may obtain a copy from the Harris County Clerk at (713) 755-6411, or visit their web site at ccinfo@cco.hctx.net

Call OSBCA Committee of Five at 713-681-0560. Leave your name and phone number. Your call will be returned.
