BEAUTIFICATION

We all went through the ugly effect that late Heavy Trash collection had on the appearance of our neighborhood. No collection of the two months of heavy trash was not our fault or responsibility. OSBCA worked on solving the problem and waited it out. We, as residents, sighed with relief when the Solid Waste Dept. finally did its job.

Now, folks of OSB, we as residents DO have the responsibility of maintaining the property on which we live. As I have driven through the neighbor in the past few weeks, I have seen at least ten (10) to fifteen (15) yards/vacant lots that are grossly overgrown and in need of mowing. In addition, I have noticed an extremely amount of litter and clutter on private properties. Litter is in the ditches, on our streets, city codes/deed restrictions are being violated.

Residents, we must do our part to keep our neighborhood from being trashed out and ugly, we are responsible! Please mow, pick up litter and follow City Codes and Deed Restrictions.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping goes right along with beautification. It is time to pull ALL the DEAD plants out and doctor our lawns for brown spot and insects. I am not an expert on lawn maintenance, but I do recognize a fungus (brown spot), grub worms (insects).

I have been advised to "steer clear" of Feed & Weed. It may cause damage to trees and scrubs. Check with a "real" landscaper/knowledgeable nursery personal to answer your questions.

DUMPING IN OUR OSB AREA

An incident of "dumping" was caught on a resident's camera at 2:50 a.m., July 30, on the dead end of Counter Point, north of Hammerly. A white van backed into the end of the street and unloaded an old piece of fence and a pile of new fence waste material. Because no license plate could be seen, the resident called 311. A SR# was issued. Pictures and the SR# was sent to Liz, chief of staff, in Amy Peck's office. Action has been taken to remove the "dumped" material.

I have notice that a load of old furniture has been dumped in the cul-de-sac at the south end of Counter Point. I have a feeling that the apartment residents on Highcrest are responsible for this "early" heavy trash. Please note, Heavy Trash not on private property, WILL NOT BE PICKED UP! Therefore, it is considered "DUMPING".

The POINT is, if you see anyone in the act of "Dumping", try to get a vehicle license plate number so the police can get involved. Call 713-884-3131. Otherwise, call 311 and report it and get a SR#. Notify Amy Peck's office: Liz—832-393-3379, or me, Jo Lightsey, 713-681-0560. Leave a message slowly, name and phone number.

"DUMPING" is ILLEGAL and UNACCEPTABLE!

Due to the Bugler's deadline, I will post our Citizens on Patrol (COP) hours for July in September's newsletters. I was quite concerned about the number of police reports filed for July. We had three (3) incidents reported for June and 19 incidents for July! Also, very alarming was the number of aggravated and simple assaults reported. The 7500 Block of Highcrest had five (5) incidents reported, one simple assault, two aggravated assaults and two (2) property crime (destruction, damage, vandalism).

Our HPD store front is still closed at this time, we have been asked to direct any HPD questions or concerns to the NW station at 6000 Teague until further notice. Their phone number is 832-394-5500. Please keep your eyes and ears open and if you notice any suspicious activity, please contact Houston police department.

As always, don't be a victim of a crime of opportunity!

POOPER SCOOPER LAW... LEASH LAW

There is a City of Houston ordinance relating to picking up fecal matter deposited by owned dogs on property which does not belong to the owner of the dog. Section 6-24.

In addition, there is a leash law. One must always have a dog on a leash when not behind a fence in one's yard. (I do not have that Section #).

Pooper Scooper first: I am going to make this message SIMPLE.

I have noticed that folks are walking their dogs in the neighborhood. I have observed that the walkers are allowing the dogs to "Poop" in neighbor's yards and not picking it up. It is the duty of the walker to remove the "poop" by scooping it up with a poop scoop bag. (These bags are available in super markets, etc.) Or provide your own.

The fine for each violation is no less than \$75 or more than \$500.

Second: Loose dogs and leash law.

OSB has a lot of loose dogs. A dog must be on a leash when not contained in a yard or house. We have had two or three incidences where persons have been bitten by a loose dog running out while the person is delivering newsletters. Also, when a leashed dog is being walk, dogs run out and are aggressive to the walker and to the dog. Fines for individuals who violate this law can be ticketed if HPD is given the dog's address.

So OSB residents, PLEASE observe the above laws. Scoop the poop and hang on to your dog.


