

Our Citizens on Patrol (CP) group reported 29.5 hours for March. Due to the Bugler deadline, I will have to report our patrol hours for April in June's newsletter. I heard on the news that HPD had in custody one suspect for the March 28 homicide on Long Point. It is very upsetting to also hear that he was out on bond for another murder.

As always, I want to thank our CP volunteers for patrolling our area whenever possible. I do believe we make a difference.

Be aware of your surroundings! Stay alert, be diligent and report any incidents that you see or hear. If the police department is not aware of anything going on in our neighborhood, they will not patrol our area. You can call the non-emergency number at 713-884-3131. If it is life-threatening situation, please call 911!

JOIN OSBCA'S CITIZENS ON PATROL

For OSBCA to have a Citizens on Patrol, we have to have a minimum of eight (8) volunteers. We also commit to patrol a minimum of 30 hours per month and submit a monthly report detailing our CP's activity. We invite you to join!

The following are the minimum qualifications and standards to become a volunteer:

- 18 years of age or older
- Valid Texas Driver License
- Pass Police Department background check
- Must be trained by the Houston Police Dept.

RECYCLING – WHAT YOU CAN AND CANNOT PUT IN YOUR GREEN BIN

YES! Put these in your recycling bin:

- **Metal and Cans:** Aluminum and Tin Cans. Examples include soup cans, vegetable cans, fruit cans, coffee cans (emptied and rinsed)
- Cartons: Both gable top and shelf-stable food and beverage cartons. Examples include milk cartons, juice cartons, soup cartons, soy milk/alternative milk cartons (emptied and rinsed)
- Glass: Bottles, jugs and jars only (emptied and rinsed)
- Paper: Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper
- Cardboard: Cardboard and cereal boxes (emptied of packing materials and flattened)
- **Plastic:** Bottles, tubs and jugs #1 5 and 7. Examples include water and soda bottles, milk jugs, yogurt cups, margarine tubs, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles. (emptied and rinsed)

Do NOT put the following in your GREEN RECYCLING bin:

- Batteries/Electronics
- Shredded Paper
- Tanglers (cords, hoses, wires, clothing)
- Food/Liquids
- Trash and Bagged Recycling
- Furniture and Household Goods
- Scrap Wood and Scrap Metal (NO Helium Tanks)
- Yard Waste

- Building use
- Setbacks
- Lot and/or building size
- Building height
- Number of structures on lot
- Fence height

BEAUTIFICATION

Thank you, LMC, for taking care of our OSB Esplanades at Hammerly/Wirt Rd. and Antoine/Long Point. Thank you, Nino Roman for taking care of our irrigation systems on our esplanades.

The Solid Waste Dept. has been pretty good about picking up Heavy Trash and has been on schedule for garbage and only a day late, Saturday, for recycling. It is still important that we, as residents, do our part. Place those garbage and recycling containers at least 3 feet apart when put on curbside.

In addition, PLEASE follow the Heavy Trash schedule. If in doubt, call 3-1-1 as to what heavy trash is to be picked up that month.

A lot of yard work is going on. Remember to have yard clippings, leaves, weeds, etc., picked up, one must place them in City of Houston approved 100% compostable Lawn & Leaf Bags.

I have found that the best such bags are found at Home Depot. They are 33 gal in size. EcoGuard brand. These bags are collected every Friday. Black bags on the curbside will not be picked up. And don't be guilty of putting these black bags in the garbage bin. Yep, we have all been guilty of doing it. It is against City of Houston Code. Please use the approved Leaf bags.

Tied Bundles of tree limbs and bushes, 3 to 4 foot in length, no more than 40 lbs. in weight, should also be collected on Fridays. **Call 3-1-1 if they are not collected.**

Thank you, residents, for picking up litter in your yards, ditches and streets. We are all responsible for keeping our neighborhood clean and attractive.

REMINDERS THAT THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED:

- There should be no trailer in your driveway. Box trucks parked in driveways or on street are unacceptable.
- Vehicles parked in the yard, on the sidewalk, facing the wrong way on street, parked overnight, without moving for 24 hours, are city code violations. You are at risk of getting an HPD citation.
- Inoperable vehicles and wrecked vehicles in sight from the street is a city code violation.

All the above are issues and are unsightly and eyesores in our neighborhood!

Help us make sure our neighborhood looks nice by following the rules.
