Notify the City of Houston's Legal Department if you suspect that a permit violates your community's deed restrictions regarding any of the following areas:

- Building use
- Setbacks
- Lot and/or building size
- Building height
- Number of structures on lot
- Fence height



Before your lawn goes dormant, I would do the following:

- 1) Reduce water amount and frequency.
- 2) Water after the sun rises (8 a.m. 9 a.m.).
- 3) Do a fall fertilization with either an organic or synthetic fertilizer (8-12-16). Normally, hardware stores will have what you need. Water in the fertilizer.
- 4) Mow any winter weeds that come up.
- 5) Give yourself a break from mowing your lawn.
