#### FROM THE PRESIDENT, CONTINUED...

The respect for the value of property on which you live is YOUR responsibly regardless if you are leasing, renting or are a home owner. No resident is above the law. I have gotten some promises to comply, but trailers are still in driveways, inoperable cars are still on properties and junk line carports, trash/junk lay in yards/ditches. (And I am NOT talking about "storm" debris.) It is very frustrating to those of us who DO follow the Deed Restrictions and City Codes. Many of us have lived in OSB for many years. We do not want to lose our property values to those who have moved into our neighborhood and don't upkeep their homes.

I have been in touch with Amy Peck's office to understand the debris pick-up. They don't understand the contracted company's pick-up strategy either. I just want the City of Houston's garbage, recycle and heavy trash to be consistent and on schedule.

A special thank you to Murphy Critelli for re-digging a hole and setting a Citizens on Patrol (COP) sign back up after it was hit. Your time and effort is so appreciated. In addition, Virginia Lehman, OSBCA's COP Chairperson, spends a great deal of time patrolling our neighborhood and keeping me posted on happenings in our area. I do appreciate those who help with our COP program.

#### STORM DAMAGE RECOVERY

Just a note to acknowledge storm damage to homes in OSB. Many of you may be waiting on insurance claims while others have immediately started repairs on their home. I want to remind you to be sure you acquire a PERMIT for roofs, electrical and plumbing repairs. Rebuilding fences, no higher than 8', DO NOT require a permit.

Be sure you contact the City of Houston Permit Dept. and ask all questions that might concern you. Call 3-1-1 to get the phone number. Get your questions answered. You don't have to reveal your name. Just ask all the questions you have with whoever answers the phone.

Be careful of the "fake" contractors, price gougers and those with no references.

### CITIZENS ON PATROL – JUNE & JULY 2024

We reported 31 patrol hours for June and 37 patrol hours for July. Due to the newsletter deadline, I will report the hours for August in October's newsletter.

It has been a very active 'weather related' couple of months and I am hoping that we don't have to encounter any more tropical disturbances and/or storms. Fall/Christmas decorations and clothing are starting to appear at our local stores, so keeping my fingers crossed that cooler weather will soon be here. We did get a few more patrol hours in July. We were out checking the neighborhood out, charging our phones and enjoying some cool air. It was nice to see neighbors out and about, helping others in our neighborhood, sharing generators, dropping off ice/water, cleaning up yard debris.

There are eleven plus trash cans still out on Jacquelyn but the 'recycle' cans have disappeared, maybe the homeowners/renters have moved them. I know a few of the cans ended up in the ditch during Beryl and trash was everywhere. Our 'homeless' men/women on Woodvine and Long Point have dwindled down to one or two regulars, hopefully they will move.

## **BEAUTIFICATION**

Neighbors, it will not be easy to find any positive comments on OSB beautification this month. We are still recovering from the May 16 storm and Hurricane Beryl that swept through OSB the opposite direction on July 8. Tree debris, downed fence materials and property damage still linger in our neighborhood. The sound of generators lasted as long as seven days in some areas of OSB. It was puzzling how the power returned at different times on different streets. OSB is still a MESS!

However, the City of Houston is trying to determine the "logic" of storm debris collection by the contracted black trucks. Normal City of Houston Solid Waste Dept. is trying to get back on schedule. The question is what part of all these piles laying around are the regular Heavy Tree Trash and what parts are the contracted pick up's responsibility? I think Junk Heavy Trash is the same. **Therefore, Tree**Waste (storm debris) must not have any other kind of waste in the pile. So, get the piles separated!

Get back on the Heavy Trash schedule! SEPTEMBER IS TREE WASTE ONLY. Get all junk in another pile.

We are all frustrated over all this mess. Just know that no Heavy Trash violation, if done properly, will be reported to 3-1-1 until OSB gets straighten out. Meanwhile, I do see a lot of new fences and roof repair/replacement. That is positive!

The Crape Myrtles that were planted on the Hammerly medians by OSB volunteers withstood the storms. Murphy Critelli and I have watered the newly planted trees, faithfully, at least twice a week since May. I drive the pick-up with a 33gal. trash can of water in its bed and Murphy pours at least 6 gals of water on each plant twice around. They are surviving the summer heat so far. Yay! **Thank you, Murphy!** 

LMC donates a crew to mow, edge and clean the Hammerly esplanade and medians, weekly, from Wirt to Woodvine. **Thank you, Bill Cox!** 

Nino Roman is planning to redo the sprinkler system and replant the esplanade at Hammerly/Wirt soon. OSB is looking forward to a new bed of plants. **Thank you, Nino!**
